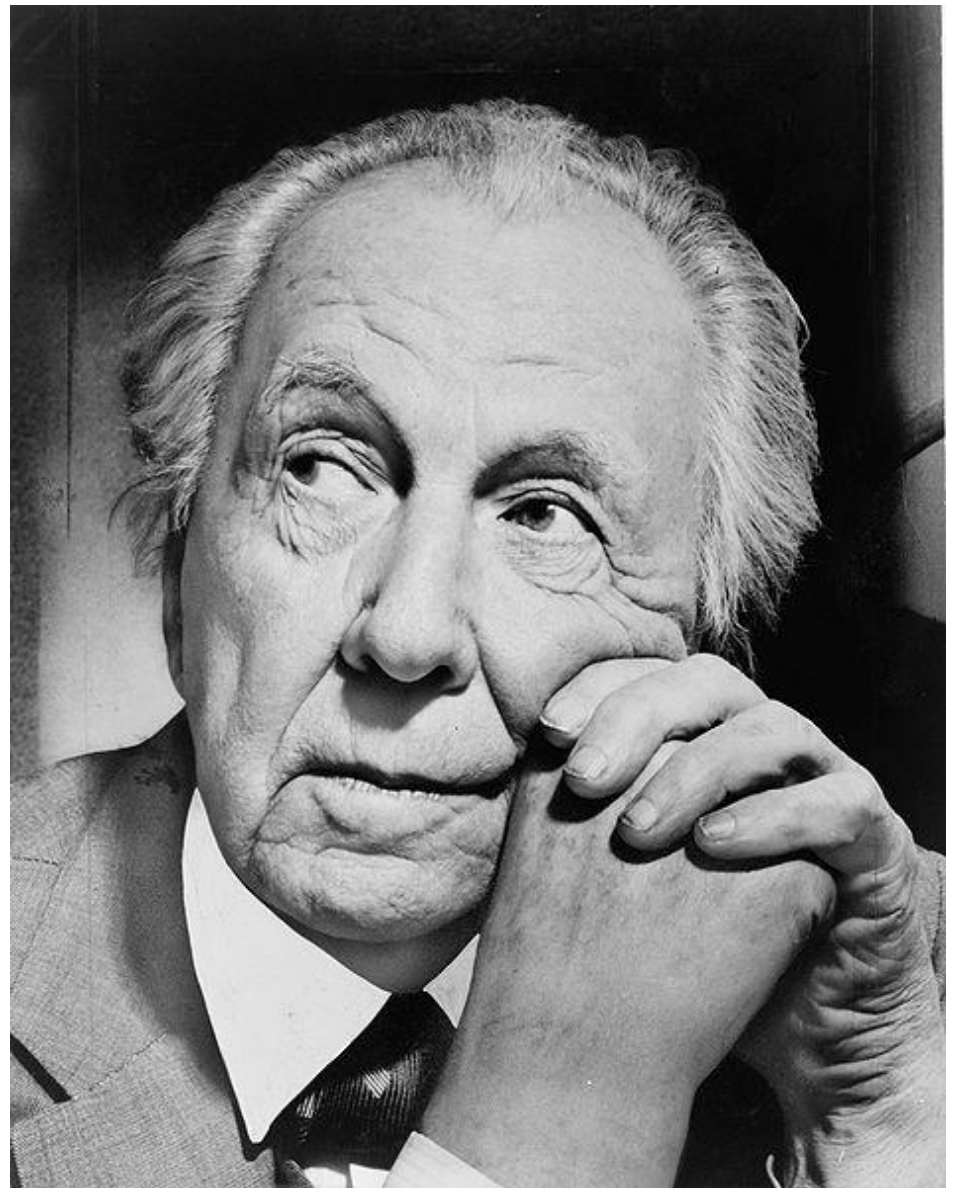

Who is Frank Lloyd Wright?

- He is a Gold medal awardee of Royal Institute of British Architects in 1941 and American Institute of Architects in 1949
- An artist
- He develop the concept of Usonian Home
- Leader of Prairie School movement of architecture
- He is chosen as “Greatest American Architect of all time” by the AIA in 1991
- Develop the theory “Form and Function are One”
- Formulated the Philosophy “Organic Architecture”

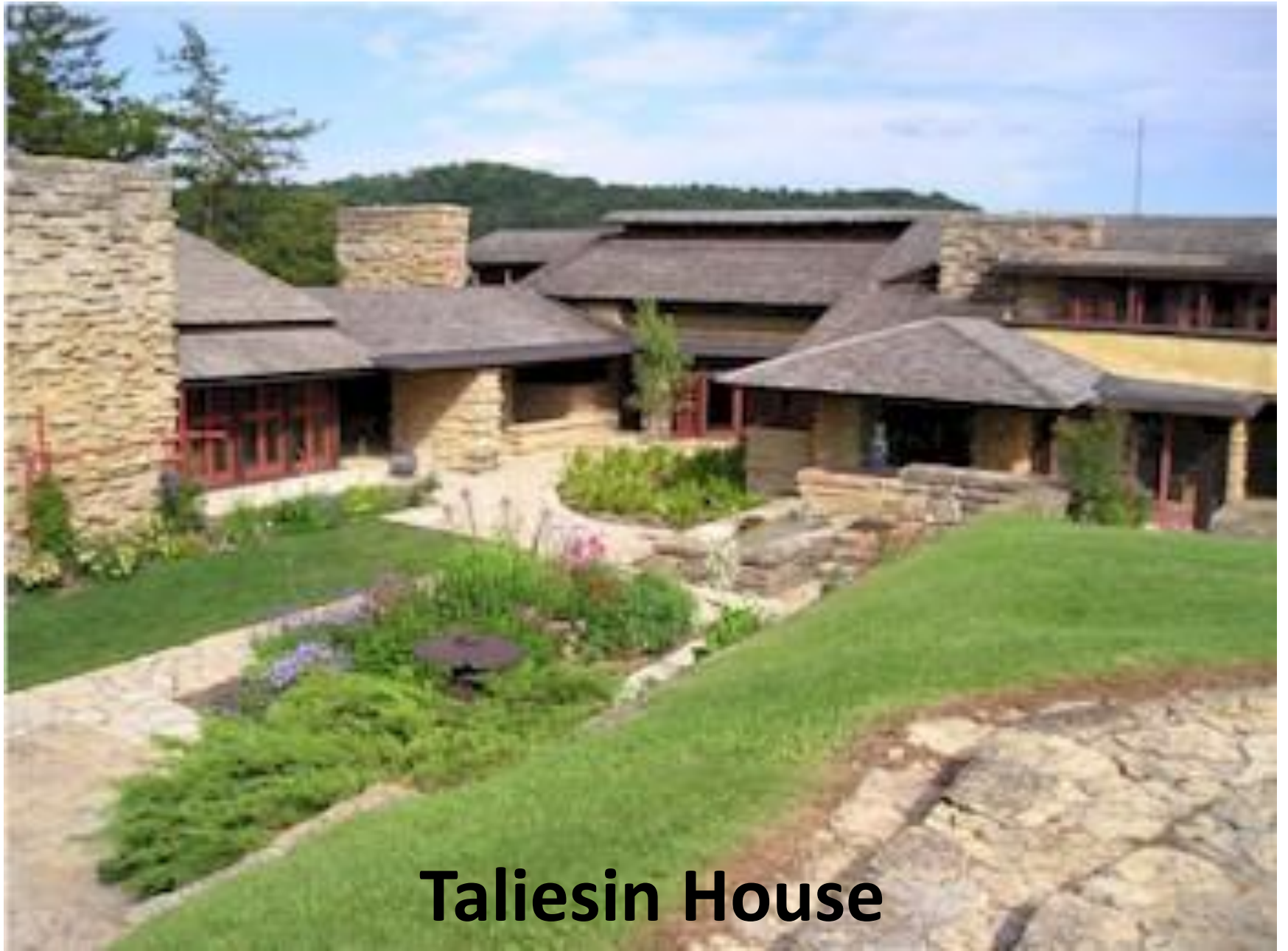
5 Influences to Frank Lloyd Wright

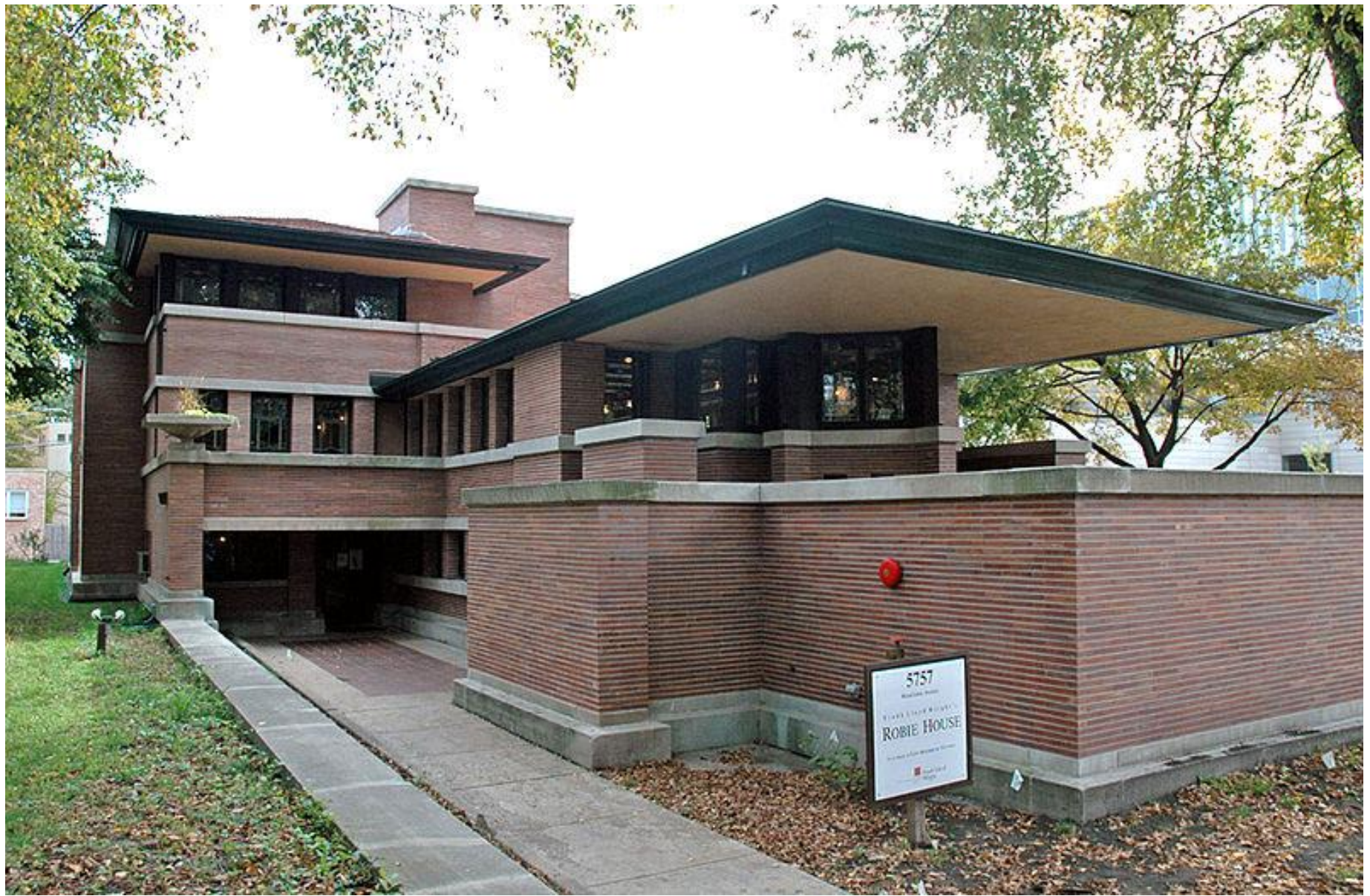

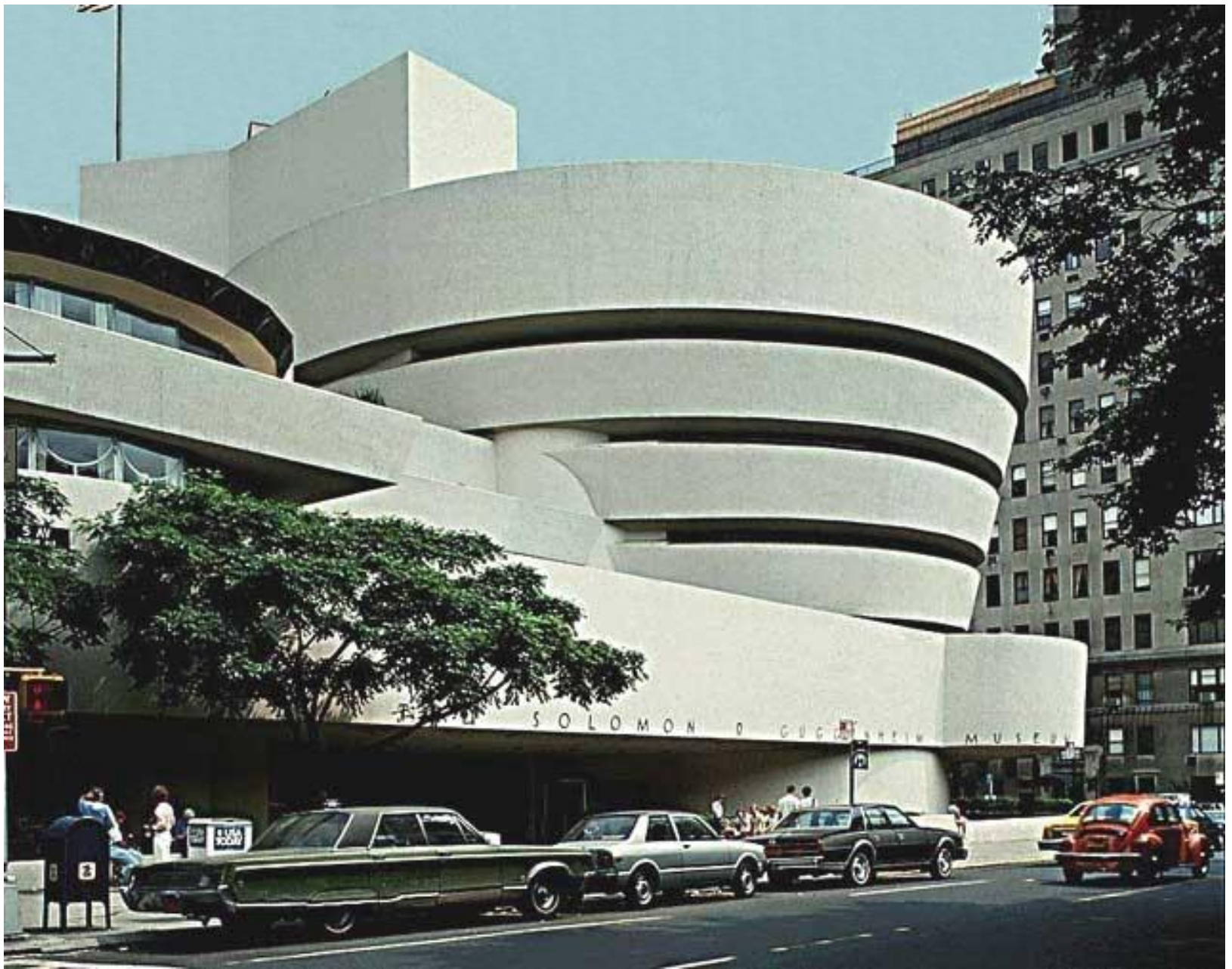
